## **A BILL**

# FOR AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE A SUM OF \$3,996,721,026 FOR THE ORDINARY SERVICES OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR ENDING 31 JULY 2018

ENACTED by the Parliament of the Republic of Fiji—

Short title and commencement

- 1.—(1) This Act may be cited as the 2017-2018 Appropriation Act 2017.
- (2) This Act comes into force on 1 August 2017.

#### Appropriation of \$3,996,721,026

**2.** A sum of \$3,996,721,026 is to be issued from the Consolidated Fund or other funds of the State, and applied to the ordinary services of the Government for the financial year ending 31 July 2018, and such sum is to be appropriated for the purposes specified in Schedules 1 and 2 and also the 2017-2018 Budget Estimates.

#### Government borrowing

3. The Government borrowing for 2017-2018 must not exceed the sum of \$716,868,171.

#### 2017-2018 APPROPRIATION BILL 2017

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Bill and is only intended to indicate its general effect)

#### 1.0 BACKGROUND

1.1 This Bill makes provision for the estimate of capital and current expenditure for the ordinary services of the Government for the year 2017-2018

#### 2.0 CLAUSES

- 2.1 Clause 1 of the Bill provides for the short title and commencement. If passed by Parliament, the legislation will come into force in the new financial year on 1 August 2017.
- Clause 2 of the Bill appropriates the sum of \$3,996,721,026 for the ordinary services of the Government for the financial year ending 31 July 2018 for the purposes specified in Schedules 1 and 2 and the 2017-2018 Budget Estimates.
- 2.3 Clause 3 of the Bill provides that the Government borrowing for 2017-2018 must not exceed the sum of \$716,868,171.

#### 3.0 MINISTERIAL RESPONSIBILITY

3.1 The Act comes under the responsibility of the Minister responsible for finance.
