- 22/2016 Hon. Netani Rika to ask the Minister for Fisheries and Forests – Can the Minister brief this August House of the areas of focus of his Ministry on its new vision for 2016.
- 23/2016 Hon. Viam Pillay to ask the Minister for Youth and Sports – Can the Minister please inform this House of its current negotiations with the Commonwealth Secretariat to host the Commonwealth Youth Secretariat for Pacific Region.

 - (b) The total number of decisions pending for each of the judges and highlight the period lapsed since the conclusion of the hearing in regards to each case.
- 26/2016 Hon. Ratu Suliano Matanitobua to ask the Attorney-General and Minister for Finance, Civil Service and Communications – In respect of the Government’s 2011 export income deduction incentive, can the Minister provide –
- (a) The names of the exporters who were extended this relief from 2011-2015; and
 - (b) Of these exporters, outline the direct benefits and value-addition of their exports to the Fiji economy during this period.
