Oral Questions

- 54/2016 Hon. Kiniviliame Kiliraki to ask the Minister for Fisheries and Forests – Can the Minister explain whether the repair works with PAFCO Fishing Company in Levuka after Tropical Cyclone Winston would enable Fiji to Export to the European Union under the Economic Partnership Agreement.
- 55/2016 Hon. Jiosefa Dulakiverata to ask the Minister for Foreign Affairs – Can the Minister confirm the Fiji Government’s annual assessed contribution and voluntary contribution to MSG and whether this has been paid up to date.
- 56/2016 Hon. Salote Radrodro to ask the Attorney-General and Minister for Finance, Public Enterprises, Civil Service and Communications – Can the Minister explain the continuous recruitment into the Civil Service of people beyond 55 years of age which is a breach of Government’s own Retirement Policy.
- 57/2016 Hon. Ratu Suliano Matanitobua to ask the Minister for Youth and Sports – With the upcoming Secondary Schools Coke games, can the Minister explain what programmes and finance and technical support have been provided to develop elite athletes at both district and national level.
