PARLIAMENTARY WRITTEN QUESTION THURSDAY 25 MAY 2017

- 174/2017 Hon. Aseri Radrodro to ask the Attorney-General and Minister for Economy, Public Enterprises, Civil Service and Communications Can the Minister provide to this House an update of the 200% Employment Taxation Scheme.
 - (a) How many employers have benefitted from the 200% taxation scheme since it was introduced;
 - (b) How many people have benefitted from the taxation programme;
 - (c) How many private sector employers have benefitted from this programme; and
 - (d) The total amount of tax rebate paid out to employers.

RESPONSE

The Employment Taxation Scheme ('ETS') was introduced on 01 January 1997. Since its inception in 1997 until 2016 the tax rate was set at 150%. The ETS was increased from 150% to 200% in 2016/2017 Budget.

- (a) How many employers have benefitted from the 200% taxation scheme since it was introduced?
 - As of 31 August 2017, the Fiji Revenue and Customs Authority ('FRCA') has received applications from 60 employers claiming the 200% tax deduction.

- (b) How many people have benefitted from the taxation programme?
 - 60 employers
- (c) How many private sector employers have benefitted from this programme?
 - 60 employers
- (d) The total amount of tax rebate paid out to employers.
 - Under the ETS, employers are not granted tax rebates but instead granted tax deductions which reduces the chargeable income and subsequently the tax payable amount.
