

STANDING COMMITTEE ON JUSTICE, LAW AND HUMAN RIGHTS

CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS ON THE REGISTRATION OF SEX OFFENDERS BILL (BILL NO. 6 OF 2018)

The Parliament Standing Committee on Justice, Law and Human Rights has been tasked with scrutinising and making necessary amendments to the above-mentioned Bill, which was referred to the Committee by Parliament pursuant to Standing Orders 51 and 110(1)(a).

The Registration of Sex Offenders Bill (Bill No. 6 of 2018) provides for the establishment of a register of sex offenders and the registration and reporting obligations of sex offenders. The Bill aims to help monitor sex offenders in the community and reduce sexual offences.

Sex offenders will be required to report relevant personal information about them for inclusion in the register. Sex offenders are also required to make periodic reports to keep their personal information in the register up-to-date.
