- 79/2018 Hon. Alivereti Nabulivou to ask the Minister for Forests The Reforestation of Degraded Forest Project is currently undertaken by the Ministry of Forests – Can the Minister inform the House on the progress of reforestation work carried out under this project in the Northern Division.
- 80/2018 Hon. Prem Singh to ask the Minister for Defence and National Security Would the Minister update Parliament on the progress of investigations into incidents of temple sacrilege.
- 81/2018 Hon. Ashneel Sudhakar to ask the Minister for Industry, Trade, Tourism, Lands and Mineral Resources – Can the Minister elaborate to the House the new Government initiative in the Young Entrepreneurship Scheme.
