Oral Questions

- 196/2018 Hon. Aseri Radrodro to ask the Minister for Local Government, Housing, Environment, Infrastructure and Transport – Can the Minister advise the House on the rationale behind the introduction of the colour coding number plates for Public Service Vehicle taxis.
- 197/2018 Hon. Mataiasi Niumataiwalu to ask the Minister for Defence and National Security – Can the Minister inform the House on the functions of the 3DP Coastal Radio Station.
- 198/2018 Hon. Mikaele Leawere to ask the Attorney-General and Minister for Economy, Public Enterprises, Civil Service and Communications – It was announced in the last Budget 2017-2018 that 200 new primary school teachers and 50 new secondary school teachers will be recruited by the Ministry. Can the Minister inform the House on the progress of the recruitment.
