### FOR AN ACT TO AMEND THE EXCISE ACT 1986

ENACTED by the Parliament of the Republic of Fiji—

Short title and commencement

- 1.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Excise (Amendment) (No. 2) Act 2019.
- (2) This Act comes into force on a date appointed by the Minister by notice in the Gazette.

Schedule 1 amended

- 2. Schedule 1 to the Excise Act 1986 is amended by—
  - (a) in item 7—
    - (i) in column 2 after "drinks", inserting "and sweetened beverages"; and
    - (ii) in column 3 after "alcohol", inserting "and sweetened beverages with added sugar or artificial sweetener"; and
  - (b) in item 8, deleting columns 1, 2 and 3.

# EXCISE (AMENDMENT) (NO. 2) BILL 2019 EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Bill and is intended only to indicate its general effect)

#### 1.0 BACKGROUND

1.1 The Excise (Amendment) (No. 2) Bill 2019 (**'Bill'**) seeks to amend the Excise Act 1986 (**'Act'**) for the purpose of providing clarity.

### 2.0 CLAUSES

- 2.1 Clause 1 of the Bill provides for the short title and commencement. If passed by Parliament, the amending legislation comes into force on a date appointed by the Minister by notice in the Gazette.
- 2.2 Clause 2 of the Bill amends item 7 in Schedule 1 to the Act (**'Schedule 1'**) by clarifying that excise duty is charged on sweetened beverages for the purposes of the Act.
- 2.3 Clause 2 of the Bill also removes item 8 from Schedule 1 as excise duty is not charged on optical media.

### 3.0 MINISTERIAL RESPONSIBILITY

3.1 The Act comes under the responsibility of the Minister responsible for finance.
