- 13/2020 Hon. Dr Salik Govind to ask the Minister for Infrastructure, Transport, Disaster Management and Meteorological Services – Can the Minister advise Parliament on what the Ministry has in place to monitor flooding and measures of awareness to the general public.
- 14/2020 Hon. Mikaele Leawere to ask the Minister for Education, Heritage and Arts – Can the Minister inform Parliament whether the 200 primary school and 50 secondary school teacher vacancies announced in the 2019/2020 Budget have been filled by the Ministry as at 31 January 2020.

Alipate Nagata to ask the Minister for Health and Medical Services – Can the Minister inform Parliament what measures the Ministry has taken to control scabies as it is equally important as measles when it is linked to the development of rheumatic heart disease and kidney disease in children.
