

PARLIAMENT STANDING COMMITTEE ON JUSTICE, LAW AND HUMAN RIGHTS

CALL FOR WRITTEN SUBMISSION CYBERCRIME BILL 2020 (BILL NO. 11 OF 2020)

The Parliament Standing Committee on Justice, Law and Human Rights had been referred the *Cybercrime Bill 2020*. The Committee has commenced its review of the Bill and is now inviting the public and any interested person to provide their views on the Bill, through written submission.

The Bill aims to align the laws of Fiji to the requirements under the International Convention on Cybercrime ("Budapest Convention") and introduces new provisions on substantive cybercrime offences, procedural requirements, remedies in relation to cybercrime offences, the collection of electronic evidence and international cooperation for this purpose.
