RESPONSE TO WRITTEN QUESTIONS

125/2020 Hon. Ratu Suliano Matanitobua to ask the Minister for Infrastructure, Meteorological Services, Lands and Mineral Resources – Can the Minister inform Parliament of the following – details of all major road rehabilitation works being planned for the Central Division for the 2020-2021 fiscal year; and details of any major road rehabilitation works along the Queens Road national highway in the Central Division being planned for the 2020-2021 fiscal year.

(a) Planned rehabilitation projects were as follows:

- i. Rehabilitation Projects for Waimanu Road, Pratt Street, Amy Street, Brown Street, Milverton Road and Nokonoko Road, to be completed within the financial year.
- ii. 11 roads under the Transport Infrastructure Investment Project (TIISP) Suva Arterial Roads Upgrade Programme 2 (SARUP) will start on site by March 2021.
- iii. TIISP Kings Road B project is scheduled to commence on site in February 2021. The scope of work covers road rehabilitation, service relocation, drainage, footpath and street lighting, for sites from Wailotua to the Central/Western Divisions border and totals 30km of highway improvements.
- iv. TIISP Queens Road A project is scheduled to commence on site in April 2021. The scope of work covers road rehabilitation, service relocation, drainage, footpath and street lighting for sites from Lami to Deuba and totals 20km of highway improvements.
