- Hon. Lenora Qereqeretabua to ask the Minister for Health and Medical Services What measures has the Ministry planned for the COVID-safety of our children post-lockdown when school resumes.
- 138/2021 Hon. Veena Bhatnagar to ask the Minister for Agriculture, Waterways and Environment Can the Minister update Parliament on the progress of new Nature Based Seawalls constructed to protect coastal communities.
- Hon. Adi Litia Qionibaravi to ask the Attorney-General and Minister for Economy, Civil Service and Communications Can the Minister inform Parliament on the Government's plan to feed and assist families whose breadwinners have been laid off or terminated due to the pandemic but who are ineligible for social welfare payments or FNPF assistance.
- 140/2021 Hon. Virendra Lal to ask the Minister for Infrastructure, Meteorological Services, Lands and Mineral Resources Can the Minister update Parliament on the Licensing process of river gravel extraction.
