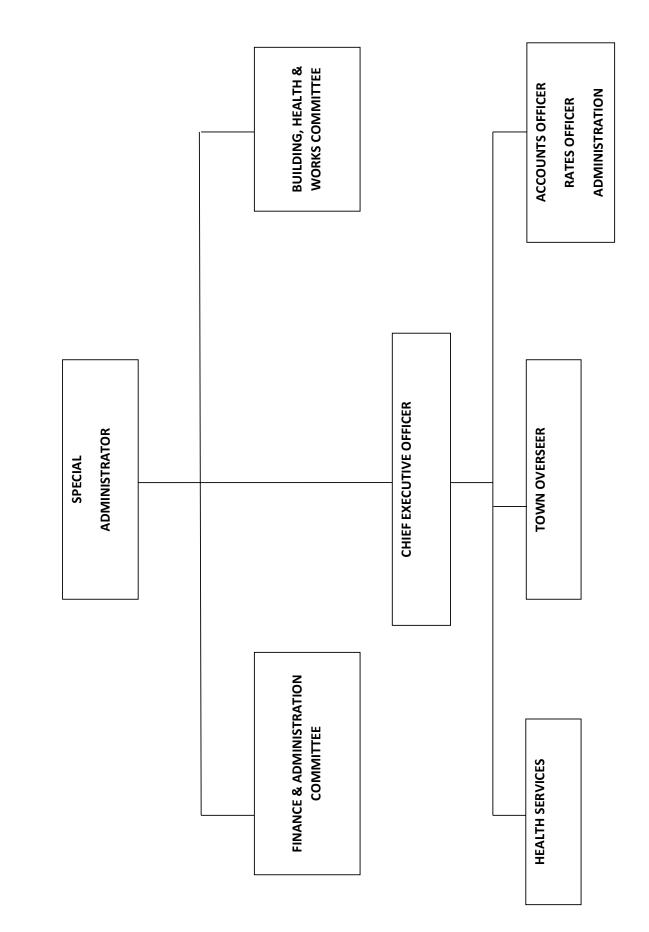

#### INDEPENDENT AUDIT REPORT

#### Scope

I have audited the financial statements of the Levuka Town Council for the year ended 31 December 2009 in accordance with section 57(2) of the Local Government Act and section 13 of the Audit Act. The Levuka Town Council is responsible for the preparation and presentation of the financial statements and the information they contain.

I have conducted an independent audit of these financial statements in order to express an opinion on them.

My audit was conducted in accordance with the Fiji Standards on Auditing to provide reasonable assurance as to whether the financial statements are free of material misstatements. My audit procedures included examination, on a test basis, of evidence supporting the amounts and other disclosures in the financial statements and the evaluation of accounting policies and significant accounting estimates. These procedures have been undertaken to form an opinion as to whether, in all material respects, the financial statements are presented fairly in accordance with Fiji Accounting Standards and statutory requirements so as to present a view which is consistent with my understanding of the Council's financial position, the results of its operations and its cash flows.

The audit opinion expressed in this report has been formed on the above basis.

#### Qualifications

- The Statement of Revenue and Expenditure of the Council as at 31 December 2009 has been prepared using the cash basis of accounting and does not take into account revenues not received and expenditures not paid at balance date. Similarly, the Statement of Financial Position does not incorporate debtors, prepayments, creditors and accruals and is therefore a limited statement of financial position. This basis of accounting is not in accordance with Section 57(1) of the Local Government Act.
- VAT Receivable of \$17,317 and Conservation Committee Loan of \$5,975 could not be verified during the audit.

#### Qualified Audit Opinion

In my opinion, because of the effects of the matters discussed in the qualification paragraph, the financial statements do not present fairly the financial position of the Levuka Town Council as at 31 December 2009 and the result of its operations and cash flows for the year then ended.

#### NOTE 1: STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

A summary of the significant accounting policies adopted by the Council is set out in this note. The policies adopted are in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in Fiji, and unless stated otherwise are consistent with those applied in the prior year.

- a) The financial statements have been prepared on a going concern basis, which contemplates the continuity of business activities and the realisation of assets and the payment of liabilities in the normal course of business. At 31 December 2009 the council's overall excess of assets over liabilities (surplus) was \$24,616 (2008: \$23,172)
- b) The financial statements have been prepared using cash basis of accounting.
- c) The Council has adopted the policy of charging to income the full cost of the assets at the time of acquisition, except projects financed from Loan Funds which are capitalised as expenditure is incurred and are written down in value by the actual amount of principal repaid annually over the period of the loans.

#### d) Arrears of Revenue

As the accounts are kept on a cash basis, the arrears of rates and interest at the end of the year which was not reflected in the Statement of Revenue & Expenditure and Statement of Financial Position were:
