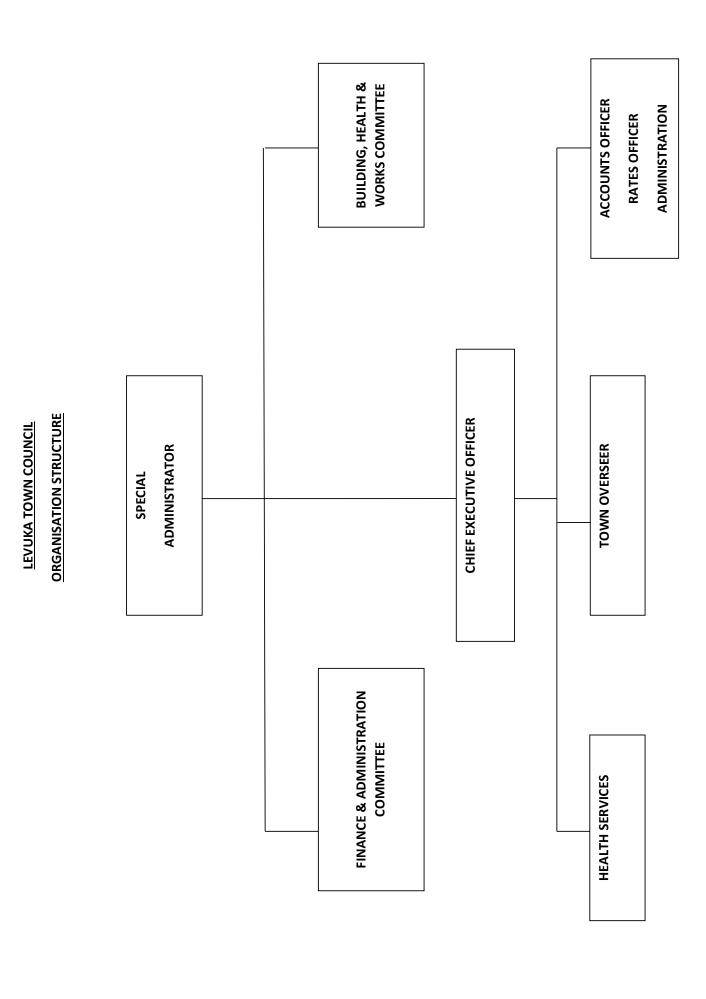

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LEVUKA TOWN COUNCIL FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2010 INDEPENDENT AUDIT REPORT

Scope

I have audited the financial statements of the Levuka Town Council for the year ended 31 December 2010 in accordance with Section 57(2) of the Local Government Act and Section 13 of the Audit Act (Cap. 70). The Council is responsible for the preparation and presentation of the financial statements and the information contained therein.

I have conducted an independent audit of these financial statements in order to express an opinion on them.

The audit has been conducted in accordance with Fiji Standards on Auditing to provide reasonable assurance as to whether the financial statements are free of material misstatements. My audit procedures included examination on a test basis, of evidence supporting the amounts and other disclosures in the financial statements and the evaluation of accounting policies and significant accounting estimates. These procedures were undertaken to form an opinion as to whether, in all material respects, the financial statements are presented fairly in accordance with Fiji Accounting Standards and statutory requirements so as to present a view which is consistent with my understanding of the Council's financial position, the results of its operations and cash flows.

The audit opinion expressed in this report has been formed on the above basis.

Basis of Adverse Audit Opinion

- The Statement of Revenue and Expenditure of the Council as at 31 December 2010 has been prepared
 using the cash basis of accounting and does not take into account revenues not received and
 expenditures not paid at balance date. Similarly, the Statement of Financial Position does not
 incorporate debtors, pre-payments, creditors and accruals and is therefore a limited statement of
 financial position. This basis of accounting is not in accordance with Section 57(1) of the Local
 Government Act.
- 2. A complete VAT reconciliation was not prepared by the Council to verify VAT receivable amounting to \$10,882. Additionally, the Council did not maintain any general ledger account for VAT and did not lodge any VAT return for the years 2009 and 2010. I was also not able to perform an independent reconciliation of VAT due to lack of accounting records and supporting documents from prior years. Consequently, I was unable to ascertain if the VAT receivable is fairly stated in the Statement of Financial Position.
- Accumulated funds include an accounting adjustment amounting to \$24, 510. There is no audit trail
 and supporting document to verify this adjustment. Consequently, I am unable to ascertain if the
 accumulated funds amounting to \$18, 178 is fairly stated in the Statement of Financial Position.

INDEPENDENT AUDIT REPORT (CONT'D)

- 4. The Council did not carry out bank reconciliation for its bank account. Consequently, I was unable to ascertain if the cash at bank amounting to \$13,271 is fairly stated in the Statement of Financial Position.
- 5. The Council did not maintain appropriate accounting records and supporting documents for the Conservation Loan amounting to \$5,975. I was also unable to obtain independent confirmation from the Conservation Fund Committee to verify the loan balance. Consequently, I was unable to verify the existence and the correctness of the loan balance as stated in the Statement of Financial Position.
- 6. The Council did not maintain general ledger system for the year ended 31 December 2010. Additionally, cash book balances did not agree to revenue and expenditure in the Statement of Revenue and Expenditure. Consequently, I was unable to ascertain if revenue and expenditure have been correctly stated.

Adverse Audit Opinion

In my opinion, due to the significant effects of the matters identified in the qualification paragraphs, the financial statements does not present fairly in accordance with Fiji Accounting Standards and the statutory provisions, the financial position of the Council as at 31 December 2010 and the results of its operations and cash flows for the year then ended.

Emphasis Of Matter

Without further qualifying the audit opinion emphasis is drawn to the following matter;

The Council has not lodged Annual PAYE summary to Fiji Revenue and Customs Authority for the years, 2008 and 2010.

NOTE 1: STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

A summary of the significant accounting policies adopted by the Council is set out in this note. The policies adopted are in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in Fiji, and unless stated otherwise are consistent with those applied in the prior year.

- a) The financial statements have been prepared on a going concern basis, which contemplates the continuity of council activities and the realisation of assets and the payment of liabilities in the normal course of operations. At 31 December 2010 the council's overall excess of assets over liabilities (surplus) was \$18,178 (2009: \$24,616)
- b) The financial statements have been prepared using cash basis of accounting.
- c) The Council has adopted the policy of charging to income the full cost of the assets at the time of acquisition, except projects financed from Loan Funds which are capitalised as expenditure is incurred and are written down in value by the actual amount of principal repaid annually over the period of the loans.
- d) Arrears of Revenue

As the accounts are kept on a cash basis, the arrears of rates and interest at the end of the year which was not reflected in the Income & Expenditure and Financial Position were:
