CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

The Standing Committee on Justice, Law and Human Rights has been established pursuant to Standing Order 109 of the Standing Orders of the Parliament of Fiji.

Pursuant to Standing Order 110 (1) (a), the Standing Committee has been tasked with scrutinising and making necessary amendments to the under-mentioned Bill, which was referred to the Committee by the Parliament.

The **International Arbitration Bill, 2017 (Bill No. 37 of 2017)** aims to provide for the conduct of international arbitrations based on the model law adopted by the United Nations Commission on International Trade Law on International Commercial Arbitration.
