



Honorable Laisenia Tuitubou, Minister for Youth and Sports' Response to Parliamentary Question

41/2018 Can the Minister advise the House on the existing number of youth clubs registered with the Ministry and provide a breakdown of the same by district?

Madam Speaker, I would like to thank the question raised by the Hon Member.

Over the years my Ministry has been registering emerging youth clubs from all over the communities across all ethnic groups. These include Faith-based, Uniform groups, District, Village and Settlement Youth Clubs (Urban and Rural). My Ministry also re-registers Youth Clubs that have become dormant or inactive to ensure they are revived and connected to the Ministry for support. The following is the latest update of the record of active youth clubs in the 15 provinces.
