SCHEDULE 1 — QUESTIONS

Oral Questions

- 122/2018 Hon. Parmod Chand to ask the Minister for Health and Medical Services – Can the Minister update the House on the current national status of Fiji Meningococcal C Outbreak and whether the 38 reported cases from January 1st to April 5th 2018 has increased or decreased.
- 123/2018 Hon. Alvick Maharaj to ask the Attorney-General and Minister for Economy, Public Enterprises, Civil Service and Communications – Can the Minister inform the House on how the Public Consultations for the 2017-2018 Budget was received.
- 124/2018 Hon. Ro Kiniviliame Kiliraki to ask the Minister for Waterways – Can the Minister inform the House what is the progress on the river diversion programme that is in place so as to mitigate flooding and river bank erosions.
- 125/2018 Hon. Howard Politini to ask the Minister for Women, Children and Poverty Alleviation – Fiji ratified the Convention on the Elimination of all forms of Discrimination against Women (CEDAW) in 1995 and presented its 5th State CEDAW Report in 2014, and earlier this year participated in the Constructive Dialogue in Geneva. Can the Minister inform the House on the outcomes of the constructive dialogue on the 5th CEDAW State Report.

- 129/2018 Hon. Ashneel Sudhakar to ask the Minister for Fisheries – Can the Minister highlight the activities and programmes the Ministry is currently undertaking to improve the current status of the inshore fisheries sector.
