Oral Questions

Prof. Biman Prasad to ask the Minister for Infrastructure, Meteorological Services, Lands and Mineral Resources – Can the Minister inform Parliament whether the Buabua No. 1 low level crossing in rural Lautoka, washed away due to flooding more than 8 years ago, will be fully repaired or reconstructed.
- 120/2021 Hon. Alexander O'Connor to ask the Minister for Commerce, Trade, Tourism and Transport – Can the Minister inform Parliament on the reforms that have been undertaken by the Government over the past year to promote Doing Business in Fiji.
