The Standing Committee on Justice, Law and Human Rights has commenced its review of the ***Heritage Bill 2021 (Bill No. 3 of 2021)***.

The ***Heritage Bill 2021***, aims to give effect to the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation (UNESCO) Convention Concerning the Protection of the World Cultural and Natural Heritage and to provide for the recognition and management of places in Fiji having world heritage values based on the operational guidelines for the implementation of the world heritage convention and for related matters.
