6. <u>CONSIDERATION OF BILLS</u>

Pursuant to Standing Order 51, the Attorney-General and Minister for Economy, Civil Service, Communications, Housing and Community Development the Hon. Aiyaz Sayed-Khaiyum moved that the following Bills be considered by Parliament without delay –

- 1. Media Industry Development (Budget Amendment) Bill 2022 (Bill No. 45 of 2022); and
- 2. Water Authority of Fiji (Budget Amendment) Bill 2022 (Bill No. 46 of 2022).

That pursuant to Standing Order 51, that the Bills –

- (a) must pass through one stage at a single sitting of Parliament;
- (b) must not be referred to a Standing Committee or other Committees of Parliament;
- (c) must be debated and voted upon by Parliament immediately after the vote on the 2022–2023 Appropriation Bill 2022; and
- (d) that the time for the debate be limited to ensure that the Bills tabled today are debated and voted upon during this week's sitting of Parliament.
