- 22/2023 Hon. Jovesa Vocea to ask the Minister for iTaukei Affairs and Culture, Heritage and Arts – Can the Minister update Parliament on the Ministry's plans to ensure vacant chiefly titles are filled promptly.

- 23/2023 Hon. Naisa Tuinaceva to ask the Minister for Agriculture and Waterways – With the closure of the green ginger market, can the Minister inform Parliament whether the Ministry can assist farmers with unsold and unharvested ginger.
