RECOMMENDATION

The Standing Committee on Social Affairs conducted the review of *Ba Town Council for the year 2019* and recommends that Parliament take note of this report.

1. INTRODUCTION

The Standing Committee on Social Affairs ('Committee') of the 2018–2022 Parliament was referred the *Ba Town Council Annual Report for the Year 2019* on the 1st of September 2022, as pursuant to SO 38 (2). The Committee was mandated to review the annual report and table its findings back to Parliament. This did not eventuate as dissolution of Parliament was in effect from 30th of October 2022.

Therefore, the Annual Report was reinstated on 13th of February 2023 and referred to the current Standing Committee to review the report as mandated in SO 110 (1) (c).

1.1. Committee Procedure

The major work of report scrutiny was undertaken by the Standing Committee of the previous Parliament term (2018–2022). Deliberation and formulation of questions pertaining to the *Ba Town Council Annual Report for the Year 2019* were undertaken. Following this, the executive management presented its responses. Upon receipt of all relevant information, the current committee compiled its findings and subsequently endorsed it on 8th of September 2023.

2. BA TOWN COUNCIL

2.1. Background

In 1905, Ba Rural Local Authority was established under the Public Health Ordinance to administer the district of Ba on various matters. The urbanized area of Varoka was proclaimed as Township under the Township Ordinance in 1939. The Local Government Act was enacted in 1972, hence Ba was elevated to town status in June 1972.

3. KEY FINDINGS

Below are the key findings that the committee compiled through its deliberation and review of Ba Town Council 2019 annual report:

- 3.1 The council's coordination with stakeholders to improve work processes and ensure that economic continuity and development is utmost priority for the Ba district;
- 3.2 The government allocated \$2.8 million to complete the remaining works at Govind Park, Ba;
- 3.3 New satellite markets in Varadoli and Namosau Wards, as this will ease traffic and give more options for market vendors and customers;
- 3.4 The improvement of rate arrears collection by the council; and
- 3.5 The council collected a revenue of \$3.074 million in 2019 as compared to 2018 amounting to \$1.940 million.

4. COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

Upon deliberation and review of the annual report, the committee recommends;

- 4.1. The council to ensure timely submission of its annual report;
- 4.2. The council to continue building and strengthening its interagency relationship for better infrastructure development plan to mitigate flooding in Ba;
- 4.3. The council to work with the Ministry of Local Government to see the completion of the construction of Govind Park; and
- 4.4. The council to continue the construction of the satellite markets for Varadoli and Namosau wards.

5. CONCLUSION

In this review report, the committee highlighted various areas that needs to be strengthened by the council and relevant recommendations formulated for resolution.
