“Pursuant to Standing Order 129, that a Special Committee on Sugar Industry be established to undertake a comprehensive review of the Sugar Industry in Fiji and to provide strategic recommendations for its transformation and long-term sustainability. The Special Committee must report back to Parliament at the November sitting of Parliament.

The Special Committee shall comprise the following Members of Parliament –

- (a) Hon. Sitiveni Rabuka, Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs, Civil Service and Public Enterprises, and Information – Chairperson;
- (b) Hon. Prof. Biman Prasad, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Finance and Strategic Planning, National Development and Statistics;
- (c) Hon. Viliame Gavoka, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Tourism and Civil Aviation;
- (d) Hon. Manoa Kamikamica, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Trade, Co-operatives, Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and Communications;
- (e) Hon. Charan Singh, Minister for Multi-Ethnic Affairs and Sugar Industry;
- (f) Hon. Inia Seruiratu, Leader of the Opposition (or his nominee); and
- (g) Hon. Ioane Naivalurua, Minister for Policing, and Leader of the Group of 11 Bloc (or his nominee).”
