Oral Questions

Faiyaz Koya to ask the Minister for Fisheries and Forestry – In light of the EU relaxing the restrictions on rules of origin for our fish, can the Minister inform Parliament if Fiji has been able to swiftly agree with its Pacific Island neighbours on more supply of fish to PAFCO to process.
- 156/2025 Hon. Jovesa Vocea to ask the Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs, Civil Service and Public Enterprises – Can the Prime Minister update Parliament on the Memorandum of Understanding on the Deployment of the Republic of Fiji Security Personnel to Solomon Islands.
- 157/2025 Hon. Semi Koroilavesau to ask the Minister for Defence and Veteran Affairs – Can the Minister inform Parliament how is Government improving the surveillance of our EEZ and territorial waters, to address the drug trafficking that is conducted by ships at sea in Fiji.
