### Oral Questions

- 266/2025 Hon. Inia Seruiratu to ask the Minister for Justice and Acting Attorney-General – Can the Minister inform Parliament whether the Ministry is considering the construction of new Court facilities and the expansion or upgrading of existing Court facilities around the country.
- 267/2025 Hon. Ratu Rakuita Vakalalabure to ask the Minister for Employment, Productivity and Workplace Relations – Can the Minister update Parliament on the current status of the third-party insurance scheme for maritime passengers.
- 268/2025 Hon. Joseph Nand to ask the Minister for Employment, Productivity and Workplace Relations – Can the Minister inform Parliament if there are any plans to develop Social Protection Scheme for workers in the informal sector.

Kalaveti Ravu to ask the Minister for Public Works, Meteorological Services and Transport – Can the Minister update Parliament on the latest Marine Environment Protection Committee (MEPC) International Maritime Organisation (IMO) developments in terms of transition to renewable energy.
