**CALL FOR WRITTEN SUBMISSIONS**

The Standing Committee on Justice, Law and Human Rights has commenced its review on the **Mahogany Bill (Bill No. 45 of 2025)**, **Immigration Amendment Bill (Bill No. 6 of 2026)**, **Passport Amendment Bill (Bill No. 7 of 2026)** and **Citizenship of Fiji Amendment Bill (Bill No. 8 of 2026)**.

The Mahogany Bill 2025 ('Bill') is the result of a comprehensive review and analysis of the Mahogany Industry Development Act 2010 and the Mahogany Industry (Licensing and Branding) Act 2011.

The Immigration (Amendment) Bill 2026 ('**Bill**') seeks to amend the Immigration Act 2003 ('**Act**') to streamline compliance and align it with Constitution of the Republic of Fiji ('**Constitution**') and international standards. [Bill-No.-6-Immigration-Amendment-Bill-2026-.pdf](#)

The Passports (Amendment) Bill 2026 ('**Bill**') seeks to amend the Passports Act 2002 ('**Act**') to rename the Act as the Travel Documents Act 2002 and to ensure that the Act sets out a comprehensive framework for all official travel documents issued by the Ministry of Immigration, such as Fiji passports (ordinary, emergency, diplomatic and official), certificates of identity and Refugee Travel Documents. The Citizenship of Fiji (Amendment) Bill 2026 ('**Bill**') seeks to amend the Citizenship of Fiji Act 2009 ('**Act**') to update the rules for acquiring Fijian citizenship by naturalisation and registration, ensuring the integrity and value of Fijian citizenship, as well as for other technical and related matters.
